



## ROY FEDDEN TROPHY SPORTING CAR TRIAL

SUNDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2017

The Bristol Motor Club is very pleased once again to organise the Roy Fedden Sporting Car Trial, a round of the 2017 MSA British, 2017 Reis Motorsport Insurance BTRDA Sporting Trials, the 2017 Reis Motorsport Insurance ASWMC Sporting Trials Championships and 2017 NuCasa BTRDA Allrounders Championship. We welcome you back to our venue at Old Down, nr Thornbury, South Gloucestershire BS32 4PG (MR 172/613884) by kind permission of Mr. L. Riddiford.

The unloading field includes a stoned track access direct from the main road into a large and relatively level unloading area. The venue comprises totally private land. We will be arranging Catering as usual which we hope you will patronise and there will also be a Paramedic at the Event as in past years. We look forward to welcoming back familiar faces as well as any competitors who have not previously been to our Event.

### SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (S.R.'s)

1. The Bristol Motor Club will organise a National B Permit Sporting Trial at Old Down, Nr Thornbury, South Glos on **Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> November 2017**.
2. The event will be held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association, (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these S.R.'s and any other written instructions the promoting Club may issue.
3. MSA Permit No. 98668 has been issued.
4. The event is open to all fully paid up members of the promoting Club, registered contenders in the BTRDA, MSA British, ASWMC Sporting Trials Championships, members of the BTRDA holding a valid competition licence for the Event and members of Member Clubs of all MSA recognised Regional Associations also holding a valid competition licence for the Event.
5. The event is a round of the 2017 MSA British Sporting Trials Championship, 2017 Reis Motorsport Insurance BTRDA Sporting Trials Championship, the 2017 Reis Motorsport Insurance ASWMC Sporting Trials Championship (Permit No. 71/2017) and 2017 NuCasa BTRDA Allrounders Championship.
6. The event will be held at Old Down Nr Thornbury South Glos (MR172/613884). Public roads will **NOT** be used to link sections. Circumstances permitting, there will be a minimum of 3 rounds of at least 8 sections, all on private land.
7. **ENTRIES:** The entry list opens on publication of these Regulations and closes on Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> November 2017. **The entry fee is £40.00.** Entries must be made on the official entry form accompanied by the correct fee. Cheques will not be banked until after the Closing Date. Post-dated cheques will **NOT** be accepted. BACS payments can be accepted by arrangement with the Secretary of the Meeting. All entries will be acknowledged as per MSA Blue Book and Final Instructions will be issued after the Closing Date.

8. **E-MAIL:** in order to keep administration costs down and to keep future increases in entry fees to a minimum, please indicate your e-mail address on your Entry Form if you are able to receive Acknowledgements, Final Instructions, Results and future year's Regulations by e-mail. Please acknowledge receipt of these documents so that we know that they have been received safely. Please also update the Secretary of the Meeting if your e-mail changes.
9. **WITHDRAWALS :** Please advise withdrawals by telephone or e-mail to the Secretary of the Meeting by the closing date or soonest thereafter. Refunds for withdrawals after the closing date will be at the discretion of the organisers.
10. The maximum entry for the event is 50, the minimum is 25. Should the minimum figure not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

13. **Signing on :** Commences at 9.00 am. All drivers must produce a valid Competition Licence plus Championship Registration Card and/or Club Membership Card. All Passengers must produce a valid Club Membership card. Any competitor not signed on by 10.45am may be excluded.
14. **Scrutineering :** will commence at 9.15am. All cars must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations for the particular formula.
15. **Technical Regulations:** All cars will comply with the MSA Technical Regulations and with the MSA National Trials Formula or the 750 Motor Club Trials Formula as applicable.
16. **Permitted Tyres :** all Championship contending vehicles must use tyres as listed in the current BTRDA Championship Regulations, i.e. Vredenstein T Trac 2, Maxxis MA-510N or Nankang CX668 or other tyre specifically approved by the BTRDA Sporting Trials Committee on grounds of availability.
17. The first round will commence as soon after 11 am as possible following the customary 2 minutes silence for Remembrance Sunday. **Practising will not be permitted.**
18. Competitors will be identified by numbers issued at signing on. Competitors will start at a different hill on each round and these arrangements will be advised at signing on. Running order will be decided by ballot after the closing date and will be indicated on the Final Entry List and Score Card.
19. Observed Sections and Route – please note the new Regulation T6.4.5 in the 2016 MSA Blue Book – “All markers are deemed live and those markers that are not in the sequence being negotiated by the competitor shall be considered as indicating the section's boundary, unless deemed otherwise on a particular section by the Clerk of the Course. In such cases the penalty recorded shall be that of the part of the section between gates and not necessarily the value of the marker touched.

20. Marshals on each observed Section shall be deemed to be Judges of Fact in connection with appropriate items listed in T7.1. All other GR's of the MSA apply as written excepting T5.2 and 5.2.1 which will not apply – Competitors will run in numerical order but starting in groups at different hills with no reversal of running order.
21. Provisional results will be published by displaying at signing on as per GR D26.1 to 26.3. Protests to be made and dealt with in accordance with GR C5.1 to 5.7. Final results will be issued by post or e-mail within 7 days of the event.
22. **Classes** : There will be 5 Championship Classes as follows:-
1. **Red driver Independent Suspension as per BTRDA listings**
  2. **Red driver Live Axle as per BTRDA listings**
  3. **Blue driver Independent Suspension as per BTRDA listings**
  4. **Blue driver Live Axle as per BTRDA listings**
  5. **Green Class Novice drivers as per BTRDA listings, Clubman & non-championship entries.**

Please indicate on your Entry Form the Class and Championship for which you are eligible.

23. **Awards** will be presented as follows :-

Overall Winner	- Roy Fedden Trophy & Souvenir
Runner - up	- Alexander Duckham Trophy & Souvenir
1 <sup>st</sup> in Class (not winning one of the above)	- An award
2 <sup>nd</sup> in Class (subject to 6 finishers & not winning one of the above)	- An award
Best non-championship finisher (subject to 3 finishers)	- An award
Passenger for Overall Winner	- Roy Fedden Bouncer Trophy & Souvenir

All the above Awards and Trophies will be presented as soon after the event as practicable, allowing for engraving, and be held until the 2018 Roy Fedden Trial. No competitor may win more than one award. ***Any Trophy winners from 2016 please arrange to return these Trophies prior to or on the day of this year's event.***

24. **Directions to the venue :**

***From the North*** – Leave M5 at Junction14, turn right across bridge to A38 and turn left. Follow A38 to Alveston and turn right at Hyundai Garage onto B4061(Thornbury Road).

***From London & the South*** – Leave M5 at Junction 16, go north on A38 towards Thornbury (right under flyover from London & immediately left from the South) and continue on A38 for approximately 3½ miles then turn left at Hyundai Garage onto B4061 (Thornbury Road).

***Common to both*** - Follow arrows. At the Ship Hotel, turn left onto B4461 (Down Road). In 0.4m turn right at crossroads (Cross Hands Pub) onto Vattingsstone Lane (still B4461). Follow arrows to venue.
