## FINAL INSTRUCTIONS

SUNDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> NOVEMBER 2017

### NB:

1. Please make sure that you bring your Competition Licence with you.
2. Please make sure your Passenger brings with them a valid Club Membership Card.

Thank you for your entry.

**SatNav:** the nearest postcode is **BS32 4PG** but obviously as it is a field this is "approximate". It should get you close enough to pick up the direction arrows. In the past several people have ended up at the Country Park adjacent to the venue on Foxholes Lane but please note that the entrance to our venue is approx. 100m away from there on the B4461 Alveston to Aust road - **see the Supplementary Regulations for directions. The Map Reference is: 172/613884** (gate access).

We have again spent several days of clearing trees etc over the last few weekends and will do our utmost to give you a very enjoyable day's sport.

### PARKING, UNLOADING & SIGNING ON

Access into the Paddock field is through a gate from the main road which for security purposes will have to be closed during the event and spectators arriving after the start of the event may have to park outside the venue and access the venue on foot although I will again put a sign on the gate with my telephone number on. The field is relatively flat and hopefully you should be able to get in and out without too much trouble. Please note that the venue is adjacent to livery stables and our paddock is adjacent to horse paddocks. We will be back to the area we used in Year 1 after liaison with the new operators of the stables. Please follow the line of cones/signs.

**Signing on will be in a gazebo in the paddock area.**

### SCRUTINEERING

Scrutineering will be in a designated area close to signing on.

### REFRESHMENTS

We have organised a Catering van as usual - please patronise it at some point during the day.

### ENTRY LIST

A Provisional entry list is enclosed. The ballot will be done before the event and a Final Entry List will be available at signing on. Your competition number and scorecard for the event will also be handed to you at signing on as usual.

### THE EVENT

We plan to run 3 rounds of 9 hills. The entry will be split into groups of 2/3 with each group starting at a different hill. You will move on 2/3 hills on each subsequent round. This will be indicated on your scorecard. Do not attempt to start the next round until the marshals are sure that all competitors have attempted that hill on the previous round.

We will be implementing the 3 second and stalling rules in accordance with current BTRDA guidelines. The marshals will be deemed to be Judges of Fact – please respect their decisions. The event will start immediately after the 2 minutes Remembrance Sunday silence.

### **TYRE PRESSURES**

Minimum tyre pressures for the Event will be advised on the day as per BTRDA guidelines.
