3. **Reminder: M21** in the MOTORSPORT UK's Blue Books requires "Every Autosolo car must have been driven to the event, must be currently registered (no trade plates), taxed, insured and, where appropriate, in possession of a valid MOT

5. 'Tyres from Section L, List [1B and 1C tyres](#) are not permitted'.
6. **Food** :- There will be **No Catering** available at this event. Please ensure you bring your own food and drink to see you through the day.
7. **Hi-Vis Tabards**, **if you have your own please bring it with you**. If you don't have your one please feel free to use one of our pre-sanitised tabards for the duration of the event.
8. **Double Driver notes**  
Double drives/ sharing of vehicles where Sporting Regulations permit, subject to adherence to PPE and sanitisation of the vehicle. Both drivers should ensure they have suitable wipes/sanitiser/masks with them to support the sharing of vehicle

9. **Paddock** – see attached plan – there will be no allocated spaces, please park as to allow Co-Vid19 social distancing to be maintained between vehicles and equipment
10. **Scrutineering** – Please raise your cars Bonnet and Boot lid to signal to the scrutineer that your car requires scrutineering. You may be asked to operate certain components in a bid to maintain social distancing.
11. **The Chief Marshall will allocate your marshalling position. and record it on a single sheet** . Please maintain social distancing when receiving instructions
12. Towards the end of each batch, the next group of competitors to marshal will be summoned to prepare to go to their posts to relieve the marshals on the course. You will need a fluorescent tabard and either a radio or a red flag for signalling penalties (these should be on post). **The tabard is for your Identification & safety when you are marshalling – please wear it!** *Any competitor seeking to gain an unfair advantage by signalling unwarranted penalties when marshalling may be subject to exclusion*
13. You will be allocated a group letter (A, B or C) that will be used to determine when you are due to compete, marshal or prepare according to the Activity Schedule also provided. Print and bring with you
14. Please print your competition number, which you should display **facing forwards** on your competing car. These will not be provided this time
15. **Timing/timecards** – There will be no-time cards issued. Timings will be recorded via an App and Results will be available in real time online here at [Leaderboard](#) which can be viewed on your mobile devices
16. A number of Course layouts will be used during the event (4). These will be issued to you prior to the event for you to download and Print
17. **Awards** :- There will be no awards presented for this event recognition will be made for key finishers
