
Driver Briefing notes for Westonzoyland AutoSolo (Sept 20)

Welcome to Bristol MC's Autumn Autosolo here at Westonzoyland.

Driving

- Where Cars are double driven please ensure you wipe down all surface's used between drivers session. (Steering wheel, Gear knob, Handbrake, seatbelts and door handles etc)
- We will be running 4 courses with 3 x runs per course.
- The Start and Finish line will be at the end of the out and return lane to the paddock
- Line up on the Right-hand side of the out and return lane which is to the right-hand side of the course. Please make your turn in the paddock and not 3-point turn in the access lane.
- Please stop at the end of the assembly lane and wait to be called forward to the start line.
- The time keeper will position your car and indicate to you when the course is ready. You can start in your own time. Timing will commence when your front axel cross's the start line. **Rolling starts are prohibited for this event.**
- Your timed run ends when your front axels cross the finish line, beyond which is a marked box highlighted with a second set of cones and a line. **You must come to a complete stop in this box; failure to do so will incur a 5 second penalty as will hitting any of the cones.**

Safety notes

- Be aware of the ditch which runs up each side of the course we really don't want to see an excursion into the field and we have deliberately left the grass long as a reminder!!
- Each Marshal post has a red flag if there is an incident which you think should stop the run then wave the red flag and radio "Stop, Stop, Stop".

Marshalling

- Marshals will change over on the fly, you will need to be ready to marshal straight after you complete your drive session.
- Please ensure you have your Hi-Vis before going to the allocated post if you don't have your own personal Hi-Vis then please take one of our sanitised Hi-Vs for use during this event.
- When taking over a marshal post ensure you have a radio and you know where the red flag is.
 - There will be Anti Bac Wipes on the post for you to wipe down the radio, flag handle or any other equipment pre and post your session.
 - Please also be mindful of the social distancing rules to be at least 1m apart.
- Westonzoyland does see Dog walkers and Ramblers using the runway from time to time if you encounter any of these please hold at the marshal post and advise the chief observer to hold the next car until they have passed through. If they insist on walking through the course then please wave the red flags and radio "Stop, Stop, Stop" to the team.
