



**BRISTOL MOTOR CLUB**

**SUNDAY 24th JULY 2022**

***REGULATIONS***

***PLEASE READ THESE REGULATIONS CAREFULLY***

1. **Permit** the event is run under a Motorsport UK permit (124199) and combines a Concourse D'Elegance static display in the paddock with optional on-track parades driven at a controlled and moderate speed.
2. **Covid Restrictions** – Will be applied as required by the permit and include measures such as Electronic Signing On and Drivers Briefing and maintaining Social Distancing on the day.
3. **Parking** in the main paddock will be limited to vehicles taking part in the **Display**. Any support vehicles or trailers should be parked in the smaller paddock as directed. A speed limit of 10 mph applies in the paddock area, and drivers should be particularly mindful of the presence of young children, and take additional care. Members of the public attending as spectators will be directed to park in the area between the Tavern and Camp Entrance.
4. **Parade laps** are optional and cost £20 per car and will be run in batches at around 1045, 1315 and 1500 lasting for about an hour. Each batch will consist of no more than 25 cars, controlled by front and rear pace cars at an average speed not exceeding 50mph. Observers will be located around the circuit observing driving standards. Each run will cover two full laps of the circuit. **There will be no overtaking, and no "hanging back" to create an excessive gap to accelerate into.** If you feel that your car may have difficulty reaching 50mph please inform the paddock marshal so that you can be allocated a suitable position in the batch of cars.

Those participating in parade laps will also be given a coloured sticker to stick on their windscreen. This indicates which parade lap session to attend and we will ask cars to parade laps by colour sticker.

All **passengers** will be issued with a wristband.

5. **Drivers Briefing** to fulfil conditions of the event permit **everyone** who will be driving on track during the event **MUST** read the Drivers Briefing. **Note:** Wristbands will be issued and checked on entry to the pit lane and anyone (driver/passenger) without a wristband will not be allowed to participate in parade laps.
6. **Drivers** must be in possession of a **FULL and valid Driving Licence**, and have it available for inspection at signing on. Having signed on entrants will be issued with an entry number, to be displayed in the front windscreen.
7. **Signing On** – Entrants are asked to make every effort to sign on online beforehand.
8. **Paddock Safety** The paddock will be a busy area, congested at times with pedestrians and moving vehicles. Consequently, dogs or other animals are not allowed. The riding of bicycles is permitted **only** on the track during the designated lunchtime session. The riding in the paddock of bicycles, roller blades, scooters, skateboards or other similar wheeled devices, is strictly prohibited.

**The lighting of barbecues or other similar fires in the paddock is prohibited.**

9. **Circuit Location** the circuit is 5 miles NW of Chippenham on the B4039. Exhibitors should follow the brown chequered flag road signs. Use junction 18 from M4 WEST, junction 17 from M4 EAST. The postcode for Castle Combe Circuit is SN14 7EY.
10. **Admission** to the circuit for Exhibitors will be via the “CAMP” entrance – other gates will be closed. The gate will be open to exhibitors from 0800 on Sunday 18<sup>th</sup> July. Entrants will need to know their entry number and/ or Parking Zone which will be emailed out a week or so before the event. This enables marshals to direct cars to the correct parking area. Every attempt will also be made to mark out the paddock area.
11. **Silencing and Noise** it is a requirement of the organising club's contract with Castle Combe Circuit Ltd that exhibitors take all possible measures to reduce the noise impact of this event.
12. **Catering:** The Tavern Restaurant will be open from 0900 for the sale of breakfast, lunch, snacks, tea, coffee and soft drinks. All participants are strongly recommended to make use of this facility.
13. **Photographer** Jim Gaisford will be present all-day taking pictures both in the paddock and out on the parade laps. Please do buy images from Jim on the day as he doesn't publish them for purchasing afterwards.
14. In line with **Motorsport UK policy**, the Bristol Motor Club has a responsibility to safeguard and promote the well being of young people working and competing in motor sport.
